

Max's Christmas Maths Flashcards

Learning objective: To practise basic maths skills using festive themes, including addition, money, and simple multiplication.

Read the front of the card. Try to work out the answer in your head or on a piece of paper. Then, flip the card over (or look at the answer) to see if you are right. Use the word bank if you need help with the words.

Max has £5. He spends £2 on a star for the tree. How much does he have left?	A pack of 3 candy canes costs £1. How much do 6 candy canes cost?

Pip buys a card for 50p and a gift tag for 20p. What is the total?	There are 4 rows of 5 mince pies on a tray. How many pies in total?
70p	20
Nova has £10. She spends £6. How much change does she get?	Ellie has 8 Christmas crackers. She gives away 3. How many are left?
£4	5
If one decoration costs £2, how much do 4 decorations cost?	Zara has 12 baubles. She puts half on the tree. How many are on the tree?
£8	6
Finn buys 2 bags of treats for £1 each. How much does he spend?	What is the difference between £9 and £5?

Kit buys a ribbon for 40p. He pays with a 50p coin. What is his change?	Bea collects 3 sets of 10 holly leaves. How many leaves in total?
