

Max's Magical Christmas Maths

Help Max the Monkey solve the Christmas puzzle! Maths makes the festive season sparkle.

- To find the total cost of two gifts, add the prices together. If a toy costs £4.50 and a book costs £3.20, the total is £7.70.
- When you pay with a £10 note, subtract the cost of your items from £10 to find your change.
- If one box of mince pies costs £2, you can multiply by 3 to find the cost of three boxes, which is £6.
- To find the difference in price between a £5 decoration and a £3 decoration, subtract the smaller number from the larger number to get £2.
- Max always checks his budget by adding up all the items in his basket to make sure he has enough money.

Did you know? Did you know? If you have 12 crackers and you share them equally between 4 friends, each friend gets 3 crackers. That is a festive division fact!
