1. 1. Max buys a star for £2 and a bauble for £3. What is the total cost? A: £4, B: £5*, C: £6, D: £7 (1 mark)

2. 2. True or False: If you have £10 and spend £5, you have £5 left. (1 mark)

3. 3. A chocolate coin costs 20p. How much do two chocolate coins cost? (Answer in pence) (1 mark)

4. 4. You have a £20 note. You spend £10 on a gift. How much change do you get? A: £10*, B: £5, C: £15, D: £2 (1 mark)

5. 5. True or False: 50p is more than £1. (1 mark)

6. 6. If one gift box holds 2 toys, how many toys are in 3 boxes? (Write the number) (1 mark)

7. 7. A small wreath is £3. Two wreaths cost: A: £5, B: £6*, C: £7, D: £8 (1 mark)

8. 8. True or False: £1 is the same as 100 pence. (1 mark)

9. 9. You have 80p. You spend 30p. How much do you have left? (Answer in pence) (1 mark)

10. 10. True or False: Adding money helps you find the total cost. (1 mark)
