

Max's Sharing Picnic

Learning objective: To solve one-step problems involving division by sharing objects into equal groups.

Max the monkey is hosting a picnic for his friends. He has a basket of treats that need to be shared equally. Look at the total number of items and the number of friends, then draw lines to show how they are shared out so everyone gets the same amount. Write the answer in the box.

Word bank: share · equal · divide · group · total · left over

1. Max has 8 bananas. He shares them equally between 2 friends. How many bananas does each friend get? (2 marks)

2. Max has 10 strawberries. He shares them equally between 5 friends. How many strawberries does each friend get? (2 marks)

3. Max has 6 cupcakes. He shares them equally between 3 friends. How many cupcakes does each friend get? (2 marks)

4. Max has 12 grapes. He shares them equally between 2 friends. How many grapes does each friend get? (2 marks)

5. Max finds a coin worth £4. He shares the money equally between 2 friends. How much does each friend get? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of 6 oranges being shared equally onto 2 plates. Draw the correct number of oranges on each plate.



Extension challenge: If Max has 7 biscuits and wants to share them equally between 2 friends, will there be any biscuits left over? Explain your answer using what you know about sharing.
