

Max's Egg-cellent Easter Maths Adventure

Hop along with Max the monkey to solve these egg-citing Easter puzzles!

- If you have 2 blue eggs and add 3 yellow eggs, how many eggs do you have in total?
- A chocolate egg costs £1. If you have a £2 coin, you have enough to buy the egg and get £1 back in change.
- Can you see the pattern? Blue egg, yellow egg, blue egg, yellow egg. What colour comes next?
- If Max hides 5 eggs in the garden and finds 3, how many eggs are still waiting to be found?
- Sorting eggs by size is great maths! Put them in a line from the smallest egg to the biggest egg.

Did you know? Did you know that many birds, like the owls Nova studies, lay eggs in nests? During springtime, we use colourful eggs to help us practise our counting and maths skills!
