

Max's Easter Egg Counting Adventure

Learning objective: To practise counting, simple addition, and comparing values using British currency (£).

Help Max the monkey solve these Easter maths puzzles. Remember to look at the patterns and count carefully!

Max the monkey has been busy gathering chocolate treats for his friends. He has a basket full of colourful eggs and some shiny coins in his pocket to spend at the Easter market.

Word bank: more · less · total · count · equal · penny · pound

1. Max has 3 blue eggs and 2 yellow eggs. How many eggs does he have in total? (2 marks)

2. If an Easter egg costs £2 and Max has a £5 note, how much money does he have left after buying one egg? (2 marks)

3. Zara the zebra has 6 patterned eggs. Max has 4 plain eggs. Who has more eggs? (2 marks)

4. Draw a line to match the number of coins to the correct group: 3 coins, 5 coins, 2 coins. (2 marks)

5. Max puts 4 eggs in one basket and 4 eggs in another. Does he have an equal number of eggs in both baskets? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a basket and fill it with 5 colourful Easter eggs. Add 2 more eggs next to the basket and count them all up!



Extension challenge: Ask an adult to help you find 10 items in your home. Can you sort them into two groups and count which group has more?
