

Max the Monkey's Easter Maths Challenge

Learning objective: To solve addition, subtraction, multiplication, and money problems in an Easter-themed context.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you need help with the maths words. Show your working out in the boxes.

Max the monkey is helping to organise an Easter egg hunt in the forest. He has some chocolate treats to sell and some decorations to buy.

Word bank: total · sum · difference · multiply · cost · each · change · pounds · pence

1. Max has 4 baskets. Each basket holds 6 chocolate eggs. How many eggs are there in total? Show your working: $4 \times 6 = ?$ (2 marks)

2. An Easter bunny decoration costs £3.50. A pack of ribbons costs £1.20. How much do they cost altogether? (3 marks)

3. Max has £10.00. He spends £4.50 on stickers. How much money does he have left? (4 marks)

4. There are 24 golden eggs hidden in the trees. The children find 15 of them. How many eggs are still hidden? (4 marks)

5. Max wants to share 20 carrots equally between 5 rabbits. How many carrots does each rabbit get? Write your calculation below. (2 marks)

6. Max is planning a party. He buys 3 bags of treats. Each bag costs £2.00. He pays with a £10.00 note. Write a story to explain how much change he gets. Use these sentence starters: First, Max buys... The total cost is... Finally, he gets... change. (10 marks)

Draw: Draw a basket with 5 colourful Easter eggs inside it.
