6. 6. You buy a card for 30p and a sticker for 10p. What is the total cost? (1 mark)

7. 7. Max has 20 eggs. He gives 8 away. How many are left? (1 mark)

8. 8. Which sum shows 4 multiplied by 2? A) $4+2$ B) $4-2$ C) $4+4$ * D) $2+2$ (1 mark)

9. 9. True or False: A pound (£) is made of 100 pence (p). (1 mark)

10. 10. If an egg costs 20p, how much do two eggs cost? (1 mark)
