

Max's Easter Market Maths

Learning objective: To solve problems involving addition, subtraction, and money in the context of an Easter market.

Hello! I am Max the monkey. I love solving maths puzzles at the Easter market. Read the price list carefully. Use your addition and subtraction skills to help me work out the costs. Use the 'working out' space to show your steps.

Word bank: total · change · cost · pence · pounds · addition · subtraction · market

1. The Easter market shop sells chocolate eggs for £1.20 and bunny biscuits for 80p. If you buy one of each, what is the total cost? (2 marks)

2. You have a £5.00 note. You buy a large basket of flowers for £3.50. How much change will you get back? (2 marks)

3. Three friends each buy an Easter card for 50p. How much money do they spend altogether? (2 marks)

4. A packet of seeds costs £1.10. You buy two packets. How much do you spend in total? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: If you had £10.00, what items from the shop would you choose to buy? Write a list and calculate the total cost.
