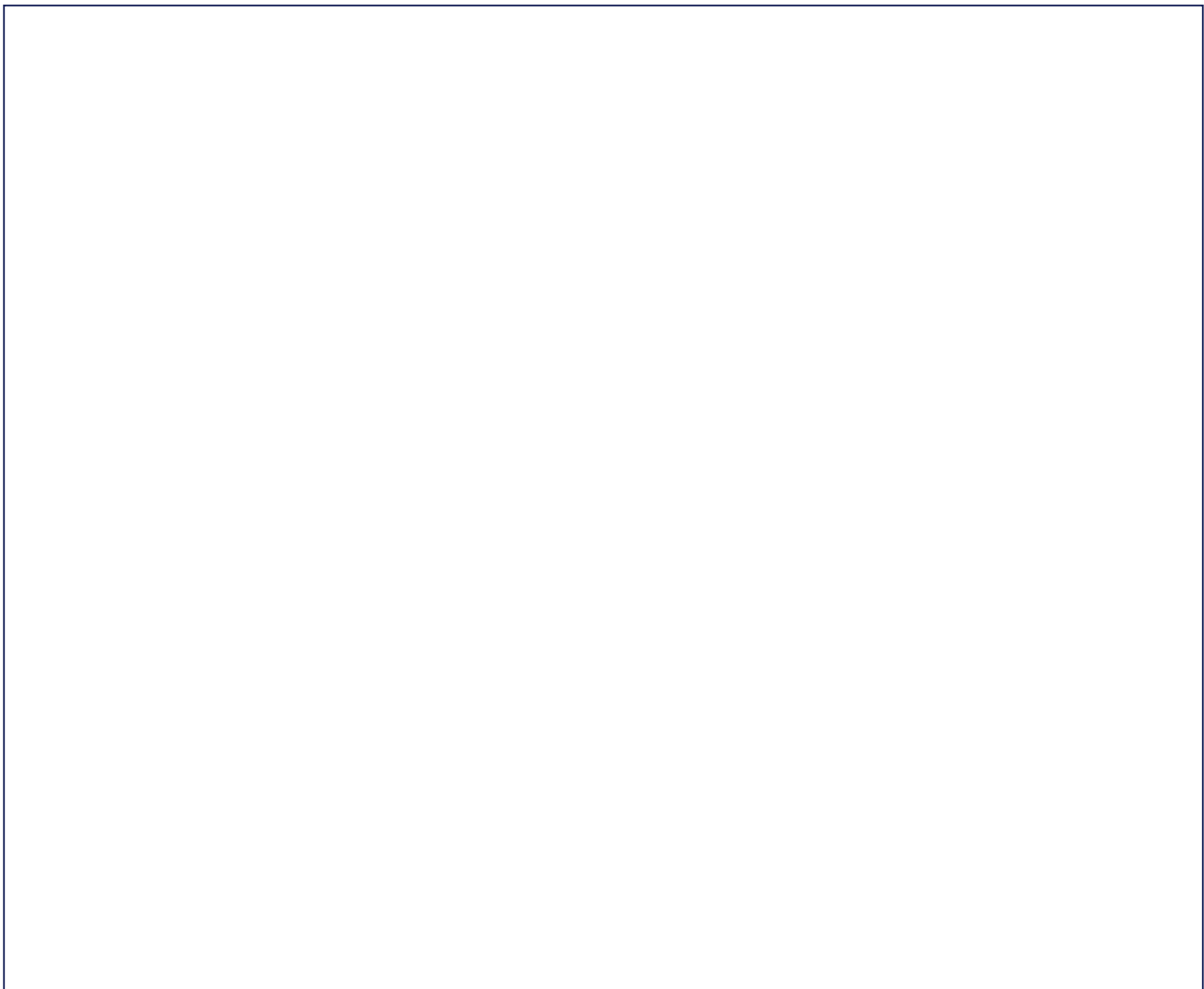


Max's Easter Market Maths

Learning objective: To apply multiplication and addition skills to solve money-based word problems in a creative context.

Max the monkey is helping at the village Easter market! Use your maths skills to calculate the costs and draw the market stall items below.

Draw: Draw a colourful Easter market stall. Include a table covered in a patterned cloth. On the table, draw 3 chocolate bunnies and a box of Easter eggs. Above the table, draw a sign with the price for the items. Use a clear, neat style. Add a small 'Max' the monkey character standing by the stall holding a clipboard.



Label words: Easter Eggs · Chocolate Bunnies · Hot Cross Buns · Price Tag · Total Cost · Profit

Steps:

1. Max sells 3 chocolate bunnies. How much money does he make in total?
2. If a customer buys one box of Easter eggs and two packs of hot cross buns, what is the total cost?
3. Max has £20.00. He buys new ribbons for £4.50. How much money does he have left?
4. Draw a price tag next to your chocolate bunny showing the cost of 4 bunnies.
5. Label your drawing with the names of the items from the word bank.
