

Max the Monkey's Shape Hunt

Learning objective: To identify, name, and sort 2D shapes (circle, square, rectangle, triangle) within the environment.

Max the Monkey has found some shapes in the jungle! Help him sort the items into the correct groups. Look at the items in the list below and draw a line to match each one to the shape it looks like. Then, answer the questions to help Max finish his maths puzzle.

Word bank: Circle · Square · Rectangle · Triangle

1. A slice of pizza looks like which shape? (1 mark)

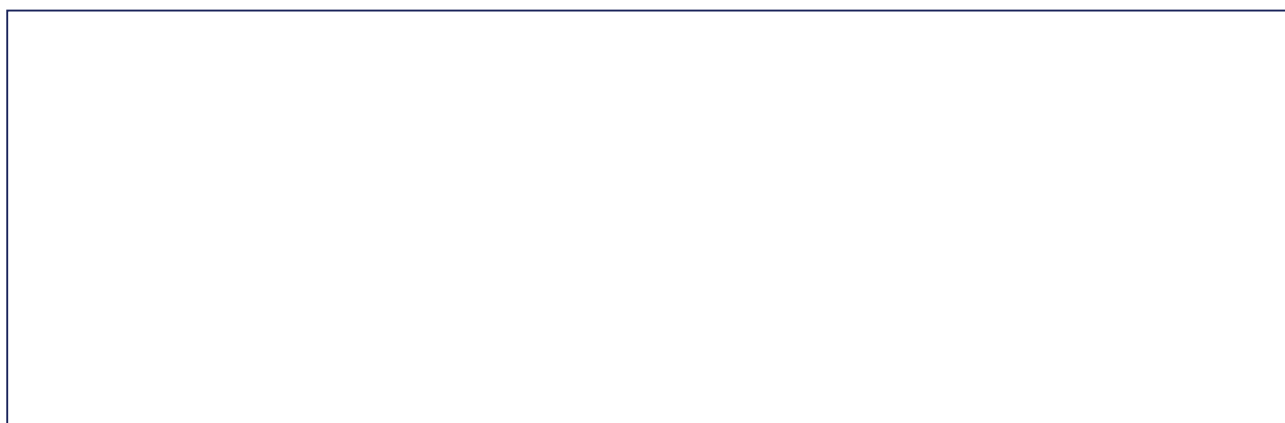
2. Max finds a shiny coin. What shape is the coin? (1 mark)

3. A window has four sides that are all the same length. What is this shape called? (1 mark)

4. If a door has two long sides and two short sides, is it a square or a rectangle? (1 mark)

5. Can you name one thing in your classroom that is a circle? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a robot using only circles, squares, rectangles, and triangles. Label each shape you used.



Extension challenge: Go on a shape hunt around your home or school. Can you find something that costs £1? Look at the shape of the coin. Is it a circle, square, or triangle? Draw the coin and write its name next to it.
