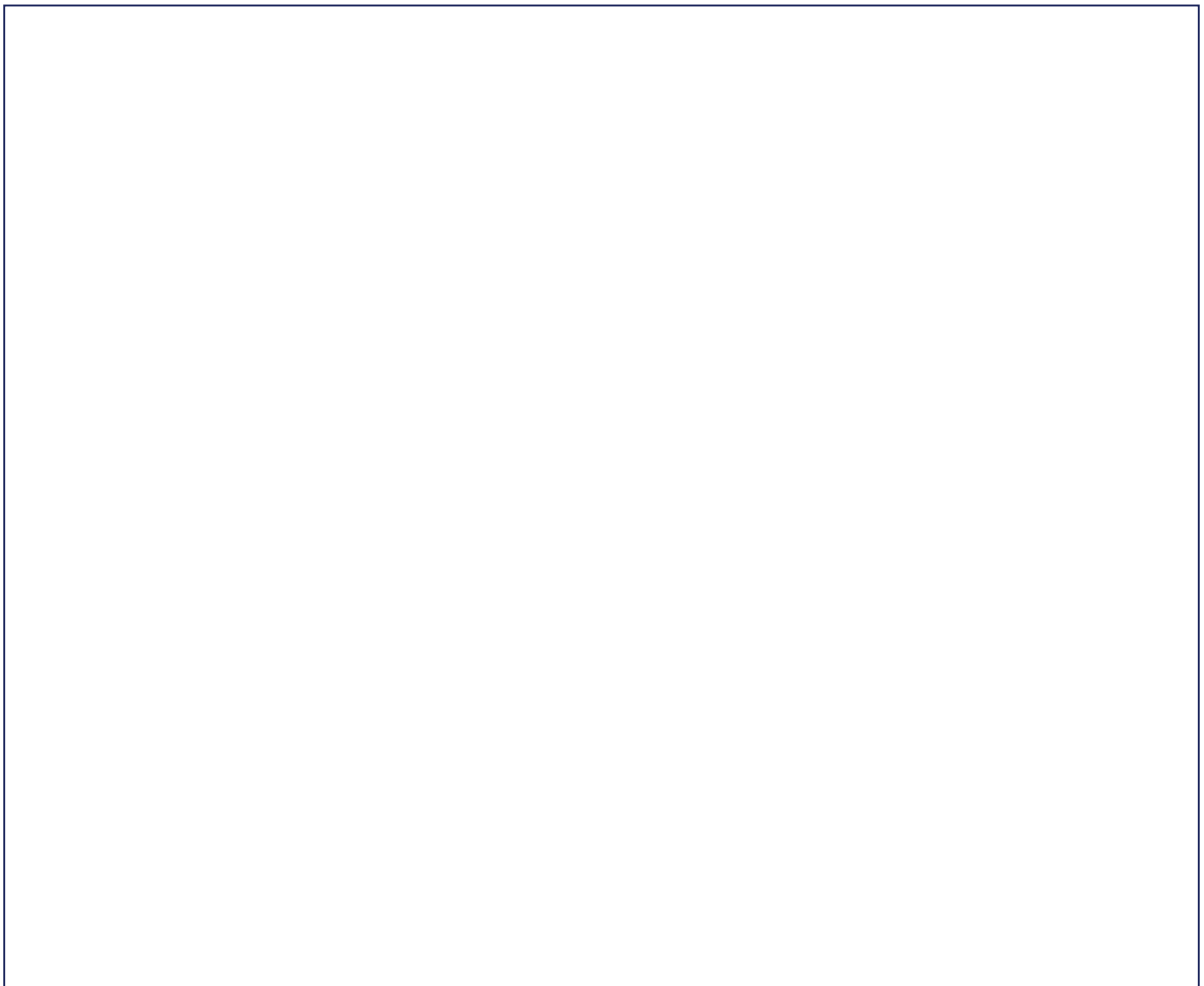


Max's Shape Garden Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and name 2D and 3D shapes in everyday objects.

Max the monkey is helping build a new garden. Look at the shapes around you and help Max finish his designs by drawing the missing items in the garden scene.

Draw: Draw a large outdoor garden scene. In the top corner, include a bright sun. On the grass, draw a birdhouse made of a square and a triangle. Next to the birdhouse, draw a round ball. Include a square box sitting on the grass. Use clear, simple lines so the shapes are easy to spot and label.



Label words: sphere · cube · rectangle · triangle · circle · pyramid

Steps:

1. Step 1: Max wants a sun in the sky. Draw a circle shape for the sun.
2. Step 2: Draw a house for the garden birds. Use a square for the wall and a triangle for the roof.
3. Step 3: Draw a ball on the grass. Which 3D shape looks like a ball? Label it using the word bank.
4. Step 4: Draw a garden gift box that is shaped like a cube.
5. Step 5: Look at your drawing. Can you find a rectangle? Draw an arrow pointing to it and label it 'rectangle'.
