5. 5. True or False: A square has four lines of symmetry. (1 mark)

6. 6. Fill in the blank: An angle that measures exactly 90 degrees is called a _____. (1 mark)

7. 7. Is an angle of 45 degrees an Acute or Obtuse angle? (1 mark)

8. 8. Is an angle of 120 degrees an Acute or Obtuse angle? (1 mark)

9. 9. True or False: A circle has no straight sides. (1 mark)

10. 10. What is it called when a shape can be folded in half so both sides match perfectly? (1 mark)
