

Max's Spooky Autumn Maths

Learning objective: To solve addition, subtraction, and money problems using a Halloween theme.

Help Max the monkey solve these autumn puzzles. Read each question carefully. Use the number line or your counters if you need help. Write your answer in the box.

Word bank: total · change · cost · sum · subtract · pence · pounds

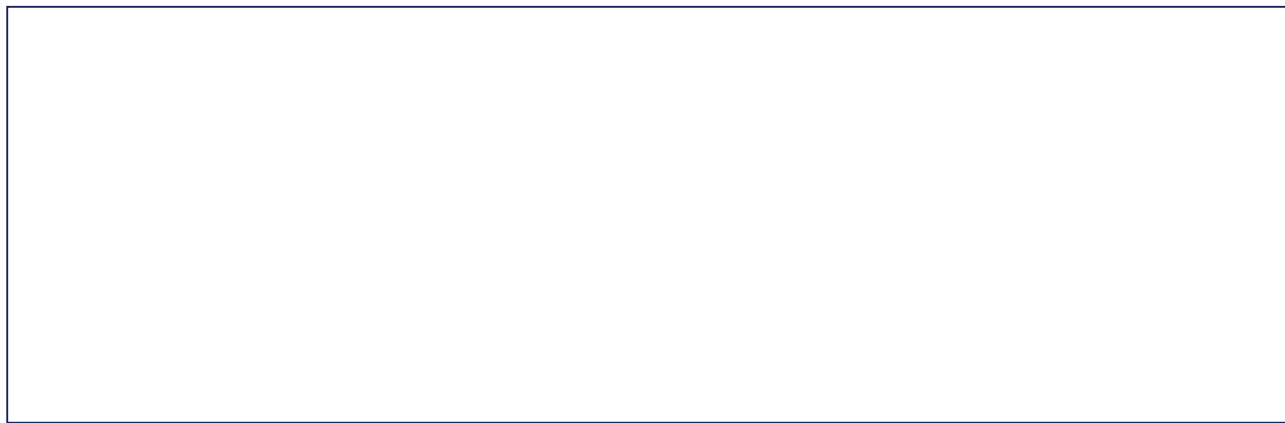
1. Max buys a pumpkin for £4 and a bag of apples for £2. What is the total cost? (2 marks)

2. Max has £10. He spends £7 on decorations. How much money does he have left? (2 marks)

3. A small spider toy costs 50p. A bag of sweets costs 30p. How much more does the spider cost than the sweets? (2 marks)

4. Max finds 12 orange leaves and 9 brown leaves. How many leaves does he have altogether? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey wearing a funny pumpkin hat and holding a basket of autumn leaves.



Extension challenge: Max has a £5 note. If he buys a mask for £3, how much change will he get? Show your working out.
