Grab your ruler and join Max the monkey to measure the world around you!

- We use a ruler to measure how long or short an object is in centimetres.
- When we stand back-to-back, we can see who is the tallest in the group.
- We can use scales to find out which object is the heaviest or the lightest.
- Capacity tells us how much liquid a container can hold, like when a cup is full or empty.
- We can measure using non-standard units like hand spans, blocks, or even paperclips!

Did you know? Did you know that some trees are so tall that it would take a whole family of elephants to reach the top? Scientists use special tools to measure how much they grow every year!
