

Max's Market Stall: Measuring Length

Learning objective: To measure and draw objects using centimetres (cm) and millimetres (mm).

Max the monkey is setting up a fruit stall! Use your ruler to help Max draw his items. Follow the steps below to make sure everything is the right size.

Draw: Draw a simple market stall scene. In the centre, draw a banana that is exactly 8cm long. Next to it, draw a small circular grape that is 15mm wide. Above the fruit, draw a rectangular wooden sign that is 10cm tall. Use your ruler to ensure the lines are the correct length. You can use coloured pencils to make the fruit look bright and fresh.



Label words: centimetres · millimetres · ruler · length · measure

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a banana for Max that is 8 centimetres (cm) long. Use your ruler to check the length.
2. Step 2: Draw a small grape next to the banana that is 15 millimetres (mm) wide.
3. Step 3: Draw a wooden sign for the stall that is 10 centimetres (cm) tall.
4. Step 4: Label your drawing by writing '8cm' next to the banana and '15mm' next to the grape.
