4. Max drinks 1.5 litres of water. How many millilitres is this? A) 150ml B) 1500ml* C) 15ml D) 15,000ml (1 mark)

5. What is 500 grams written in kilograms? (1 mark)

6. If a tree branch is 3 metres long, how many centimetres long is it? (1 mark)

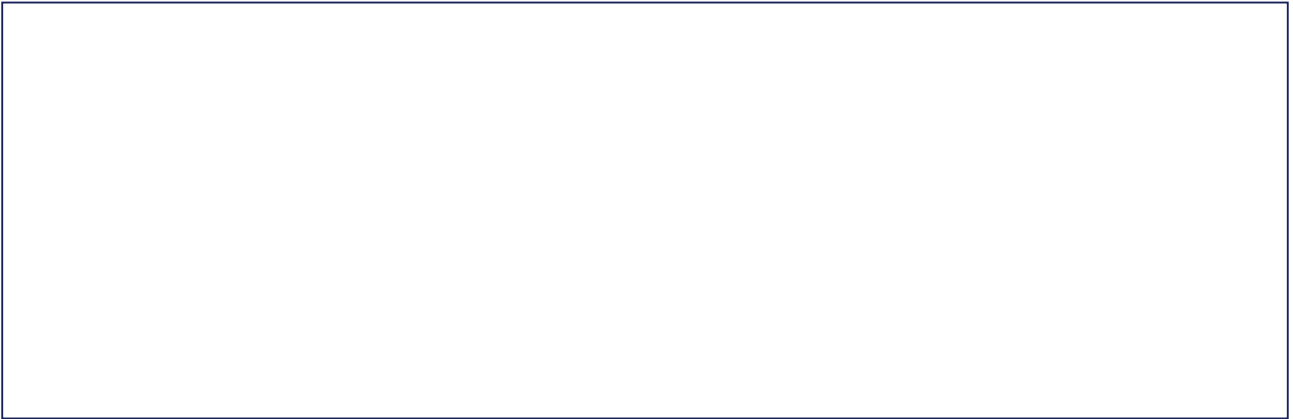
7. True or False: 2500 millilitres is less than 2 litres. (1 mark)

8. Max cycles 4.5 kilometres. How many metres is this? (1 mark)

9. Max buys a snack for £1.25 and a drink for £2.25. How much does he spend in total? (1 mark)

10. How many minutes are there in 10 hours? (1 mark)
