

Max's Market Maths Challenge

Learning objective: To practise mental addition and subtraction with money.

Max the monkey is helping at the market today. Use your mental maths skills to help him work out the totals. Read the prices carefully. Write your answer in the box.

Max the monkey is at the fruit stall. An apple costs £2. A banana costs £1. A bag of grapes costs £3. Max needs to add the prices together to find the total cost for his friends.

Word bank: total · change · pence · pounds · subtract · add

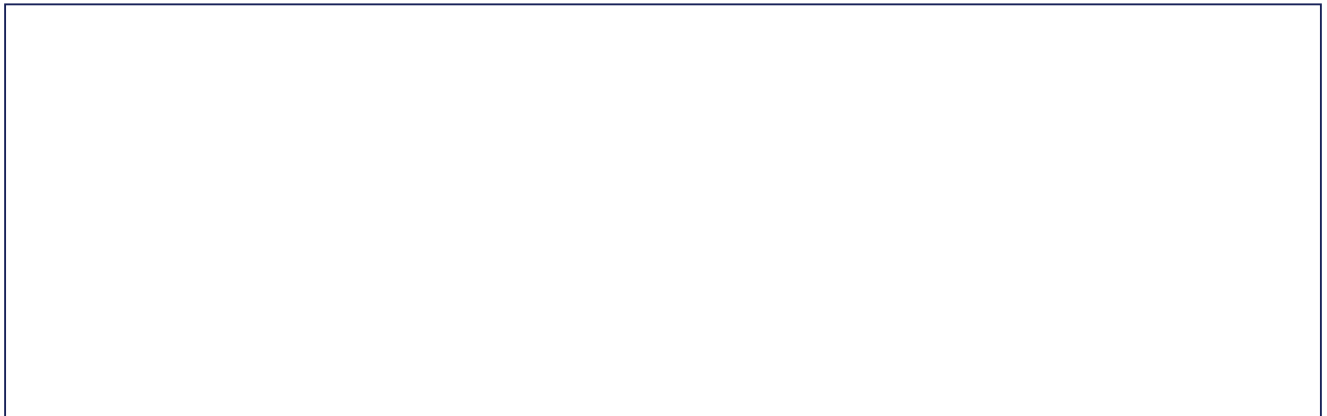
- 1. Max buys one apple (£2) and one banana (£1). What is the total cost? (2 marks)**

- 2. Max has £5. He spends £3 on grapes. How much money does he have left? (2 marks)**

- 3. An orange costs £2. A pear costs £2. How much do they cost altogether? (2 marks)**

- 4. Max has £10. He spends £4 on fruit. How much change does he get? (2 marks)**
