Let's count our coins with Max to see what we can buy!

- A 1p coin is small and copper-coloured. We use pennies to pay for little things.
- The £1 coin is round and has a gold colour. It is worth much more than a 1p coin.
- When we go to a shop, we look at the price tag to see how many coins we need to pay.
- If you have 2p, you have two 1p coins added together. That is a maths puzzle!
- We keep our money safe in a purse or a piggy bank until we are ready to spend it.

Did you know? Did you know? In the UK, we use special metal circles called coins! Each coin has a different size and colour to help us know how much it is worth.
