

Max the Monkey's Market Stall

Learning objective: Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes, and solve simple money problems involving addition.

Max the Monkey is opening a fruit stall! Look at the price tags on the fruit below. Draw lines to match each fruit to the correct coins Max needs to make the total. Then, answer the questions to help Max check his maths.

Word bank: 1p · 2p · 5p · 10p · 20p · 50p · £1 · £2 · total · coins · change

1. An apple costs 5p and a banana costs 2p. How much do they cost altogether? (2 marks)

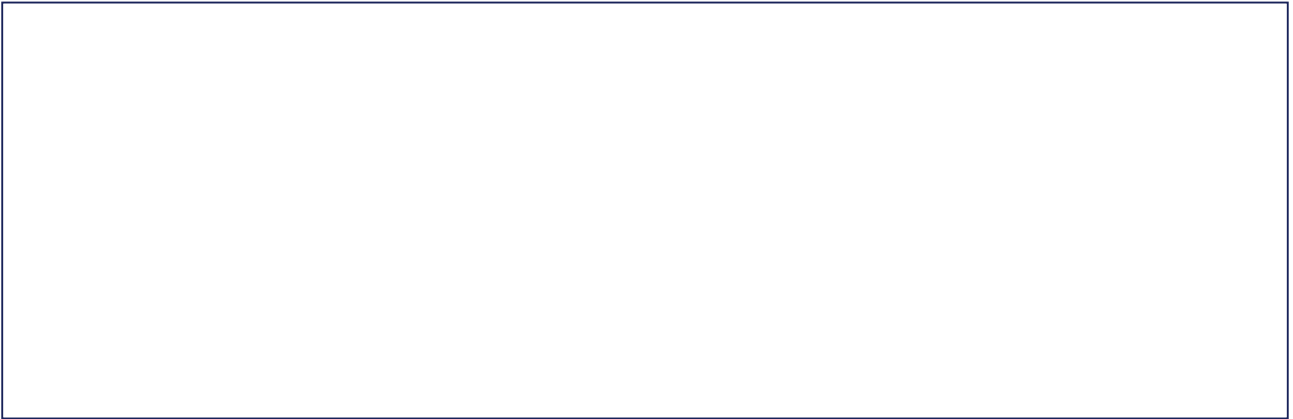
2. Max has a 10p coin. He buys a pear for 6p. How much change does he get? (2 marks)

3. Which coin has a higher value: a 2p coin or a 5p coin? (1 mark)

4. If you have two 10p coins, how much money do you have in total? (2 marks)

5. A bunch of grapes costs 20p. Show how you could pay for this using two different coins. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a 10p coin. Look closely at the shape and the number on the front. Can you add a pattern to the edge of your coin?



Extension challenge: Imagine you have £1 to spend at the market. Write a list of three pieces of fruit you would buy and calculate the total cost to see if you have enough money left over!
