- There are 100 pence in £1. Always remember to put a decimal point between the pounds and the pence, like £2.50.
- The British coins we use are 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1, and £2.
- Notes come in larger values: £5, £10, £20, and £50. These are used for bigger amounts.
- When you buy something, the 'change' is the money you get back if you pay with more than the item costs.
- To find the total, you add up the cost of all the items in your basket.

Did you know? Did you know? The smallest coin in the UK is the 1p coin, which is made of copper-plated steel. If you collect one hundred of them, you have exactly £1.00!
