1. 1. Max has 3 bags. Each bag has 4 bananas. How many bananas in total? A) 7 B) 1 C) 12* D) 10 (1 mark)

2. 2. Which sign means to multiply? A) $\times$ B) $+$ C) $-$ D) $=$ (1 mark)

3. 3. True or False: 6×2 is the same as 12. (True/False) (1 mark)

4. 4. What is 3×10 ? (1 mark)

5. 5. An [array] is a way to show a multiplication sum using dots. Which shape is an array? A) A circle B) A grid* C) A line (1 mark)

6. 6. True or False: $9 \times 2 = 20$. (True/False) (1 mark)

7. 7. What is 6×3 ? (1 mark)

8. 8. If one apple costs £3, how much for 5 apples? A) £8 B) £12 C) £15* D) £20 (1 mark)

9. 9. True or False: Multiplication is repeated addition. (True/False) (1 mark)

10. 10. What is 12×2 ? (1 mark)
