- A sequence is a set of shapes that follow a special rule, one after another.
- To rotate a shape means to turn it around, like the hands on a clock moving to a new position.
- Reflecting a shape is like looking in a mirror; the shape flips to show its opposite side.
- Symmetry happens when one half of a shape is an exact match for the other half.
- When solving these puzzles, always check for changes in size, colour, or the number of sides.
