

Max's Magnificent Place Value Adventure

Max the Monkey is counting the jungle fruit! Can you help him group the tens and ones?

- The number 10 is made of 1 ten and 0 ones.
- A two-digit number always has a tens place and an ones place.
- The number 35 has 3 tens and 5 ones.
- When we count in tens, the last digit is always 0.
- We can use Base 10 blocks to show how many tens and ones are in a number.
- Place value helps us know which number is bigger or smaller.

Did you know? Did you know? Every number has a special home! When we write a number like 24, the '2' lives in the tens house, and the '4' lives in the ones house. It is like sorting your toys into different boxes!
