Learning objective: To read, write, order, and compare numbers up to at least 1,000,000 and determine the value of each digit.

8. 8. Max finds £450,200 in his treasure chest. How is this written in words? A) Four hundred and fifty thousand, two hundred* B) Forty-five thousand, two hundred C) Four hundred fifty thousand, two hundred D) Four hundred and five thousand, two hundred (1 mark)

9. 9. How much more is 50,000 than 40,000? (1 mark)

10. 10. Which digit is in the tens of thousands place in 987,654? A) 9 B) 7 C) 8* D) 6 (1 mark)
