

Max's Rounding Market Stall

Learning objective: To round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole number.

Max the monkey is selling fruit at the market. Help him round the prices to the nearest whole pound (£). Look at the digit after the decimal point. If it is 0, 1, 2, 3, or 4, round down. If it is 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9, round up. Draw a line to match the item to its rounded price.

4. A small melon costs £4.10. Round to the nearest whole pound: £_____ (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey standing behind a market stall holding a big sign that says £5.

Extension challenge: If you had £10, could you buy a fruit that costs £5.60 and a fruit that costs £4.20? Explain how you know using your rounding skills.
