

Max the Monkey's Shape Adventure

Look around the room! Can you spot these shapes hiding in plain sight?

- A square has four sides that are all the same length and four pointy corners.
- A triangle has three straight sides and three corners that meet together.
- A rectangle looks like a stretched-out square with two long sides and two short sides.
- Shapes are everywhere! Max the Monkey finds circles in clock faces and squares in window panes.
- You can count the corners on a shape by using your finger to touch each pointy bit.
- If you put two triangles together, you can sometimes make a new shape like a square or a diamond!

Did you know? Did you know? A circle is a very special shape because it has no corners at all and just one long, continuous curved side that goes all the way around!
