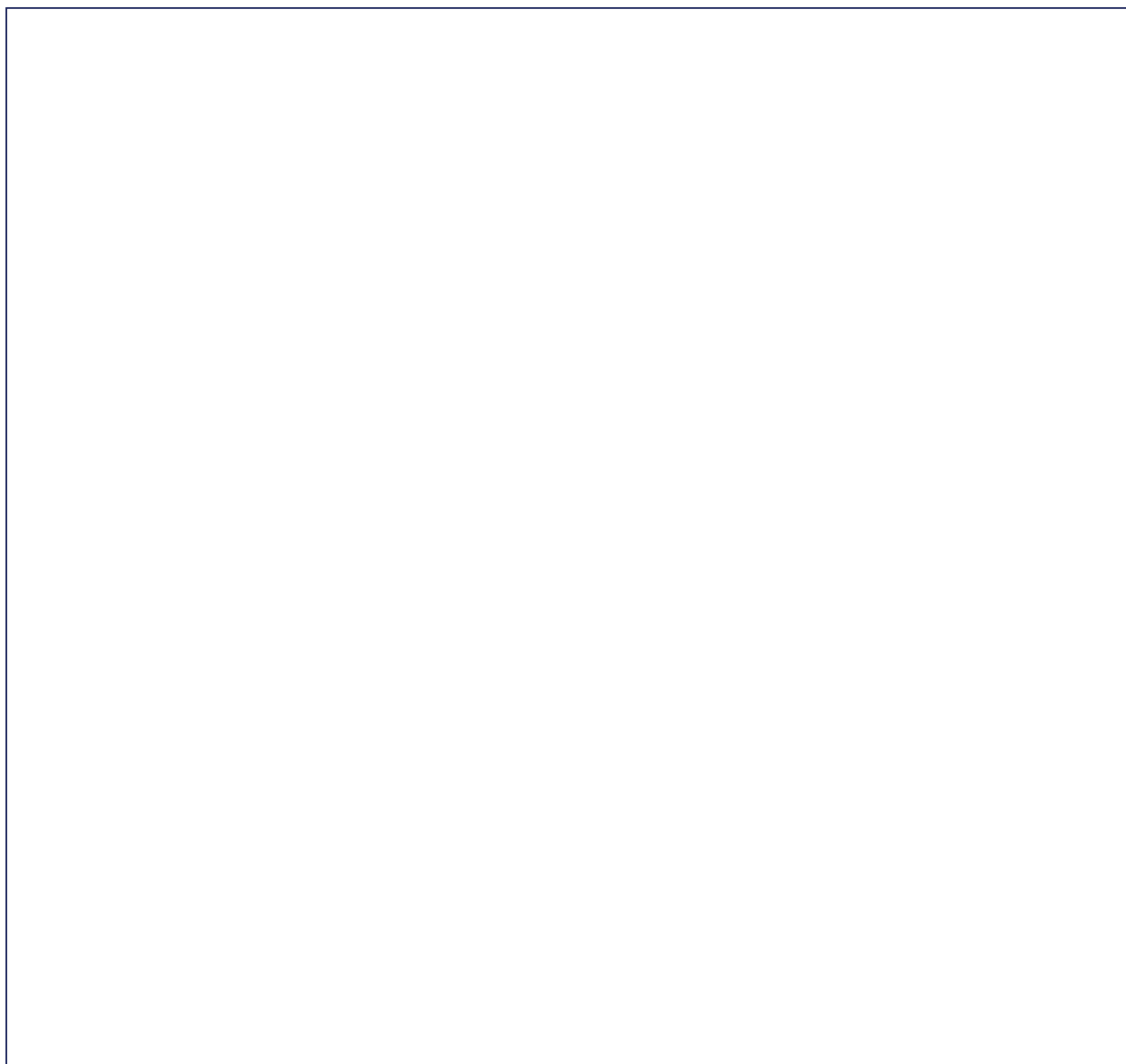


Max the Monkey's Fruit Shop

Learning objective: To practise simple subtraction by taking away items from a group within 10.

Help Max the monkey run his fruit shop! Look at the fruit in the basket, cross out the fruit that Max sells, and count how many are left. Colour the remaining fruit in the shop.

Colour this: A friendly monkey named Max wearing a shopkeeper's apron standing behind a wooden stall. On the stall, there is a large wicker basket filled with 5 round apples. To the side of the basket, draw a small sign that says 'Apples £1'. Include thick, bold outlines for the fruit so children can easily cross them out with a pencil. The background shows a simple tree and some grass, leaving plenty of white space for colouring.



Steps:

1. Max had 5 apples. He sold 2 to a friend. How many apples are left? Write the number here.
2. Label the basket in your picture.
3. If an apple costs £1, how much would 3 apples cost in total?
