

Max the Monkey's Maths Adventure

Learning objective: To solve addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division word problems using money and measures.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you need help with the maths words. Show your working out in the boxes provided.

Max the Monkey is at the market. He wants to buy fruit for his friends. A banana costs £2. An apple costs £1. A bunch of grapes costs £3.

Word bank: total · sum · difference · multiply · divide · change · altogether · shared

1. Max buys one banana for £2 and one apple for £1. How much money does he spend altogether? (2 marks)

2. Max has a £10 note. He spends £3 on grapes. How much change does he get back? (3 marks)

3. Max buys 4 apples. Each apple costs £1. How much do the 4 apples cost? (3 marks)

4. Max has 12 strawberries. He shares them equally between 3 friends. How many strawberries does each friend get? (4 marks)

5. Max wants to buy a big bag of nuts for £8. He has £5 in his pocket. How much more money does Max need to buy the bag of nuts? Explain how you worked it out. (8 marks)

Draw: Draw Max the Monkey holding his basket of fruit. Label the prices of the fruit you drew.



Extension challenge: Total: /25. Imagine Max earns £2 every day for helping in the garden. How much money would he have after 5 days? Show your calculation.
