3. Ellie has 80p. She spends 40p on a sticker. How much money does she have left? (1 mark)

4. Pip buys a pen for 50p and a notebook for £1.00. How much did he spend in total? A) £1.20 B) £1.50* C) £2.00 (1 mark)

5. True or False: 100 pence is equal to £2.00. (True/False) (1 mark)

6. Zara has £5.00. She finds £2.00 in her pocket. How much money does she have now? (1 mark)

7. Kit has £5.00. He buys a toy for £3.00. How much change does he get? A) £3.00 B) £1.00 C) £2.00* (1 mark)

8. True or False: To find the total cost of two items, we use addition. (True/False) (1 mark)

9. Bea has 90p. She gives 60p to a friend. How many pence does Bea have left? (1 mark)

10. Nova buys a book for £4.00 and a poster for £5.00. How much did she spend? A) £8.00 B) £9.00* C) £10.00 (1 mark)
