

Max's Music Room: Meet the Composer

Learning objective: To identify and draw the tools and instruments used by a musical composer.

Max the monkey is writing a new song! Help him get ready by drawing his music room. Follow the steps below to label and draw your musical scene.

Draw: Draw a cosy music room for Max. In the centre, place a grand piano. Next to it, draw a music stand holding a sheet of manuscript paper. The manuscript paper should have five lines (a staff) drawn across it. Add a fancy treble clef symbol at the start of the lines. Include a small desk nearby with a feather quill pen sitting on it. Keep the style bright, cheerful, and clear.



Label words: Quill · Manuscript · Piano · Staff · Clef

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large piano in the middle of the room. Label the piano.
2. Step 2: Draw a piece of paper on a stand with musical lines on it. This is called a manuscript. Label the manuscript.
3. Step 3: Draw a symbol that looks like a fancy 'G' at the start of the musical lines. This is a treble clef. Label the clef.
4. Step 4: Draw a feather pen (a quill) resting on the desk near the music. Label the quill.
