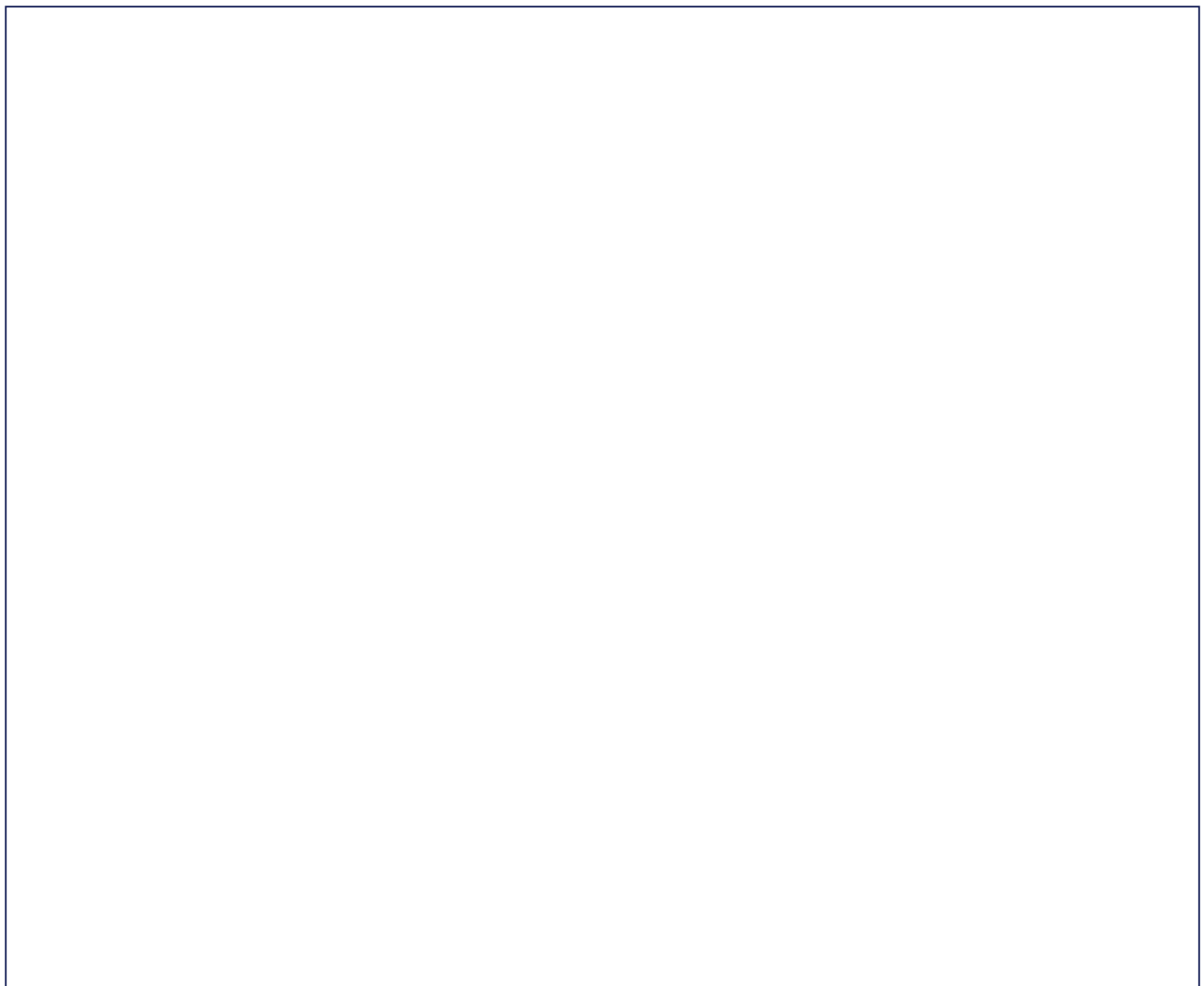


Max the Monkey's Musical Map

Learning objective: To identify and draw basic musical notation symbols correctly.

Max the Monkey is learning to read music! Use your pencil to draw the musical symbols in the boxes below. Follow the steps carefully to create your own music page.

Draw: Draw a large, clear musical stave with five lines stretching across the page. At the beginning, draw a treble clef. Next to it, draw three different notes: a minim (open circle with a stem) and two crotchets (filled-in circles with stems). Draw a vertical bar line after the notes to separate the music. Keep your lines neat and use your best handwriting to label the parts using the words from the word bank.



Label words: Treble clef · Stave · Minim · Crotchet · Bar line

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw five long, straight horizontal lines to make a stave. These lines hold our music notes.
2. Step 2: Draw a curly treble clef at the start of your stave.
3. Step 3: Draw a crotchet (a filled-in circle with a stem) on the third line.
4. Step 4: Draw a vertical bar line to finish your bar of music.
