

Max's Musical Pitch Flashcards

Learning objective: To understand the meaning of pitch in music and how it relates to high and low sounds.

Read the front of the card. Think about the answer. Turn it over or look at the back to check if you are right. Max the monkey is here to help you learn!

What is Pitch?

Pitch is how high or low a sound is.

If a sound is 'high', what does it sound like?

It sounds like a squeak or a bird chirping.

If a sound is 'low', what does it sound like?

It sounds like a deep growl or a rumble.

What happens to the pitch when an object vibrates very fast?

The pitch becomes higher.

What happens to the pitch when an object vibrates slowly?

The pitch becomes lower.

Is the sound of a whistle high or low?

High.

Is the sound of a big drum high or low?

Low.

What do we call a series of different pitches played one after another?

A melody.

Does a short string on a guitar make a high or low sound?

A high sound.

Does a long, thick string on a guitar make a high or low sound?

A low sound.
