

Max's Musical Morning

Learning objective: To understand how to use our voices and bodies to create different musical sounds.

Max the monkey is learning to sing! Look at the list of musical sounds below. Match each sound to the correct part of the body we use to make it. Draw a line from the sound to the body part.

Word bank: Clapping · Humming · Stamping · Whistling · Lips · Hands · Feet · Throat

1. 1. Which body part do we use to make a humming sound? (Hint: Think about your neck!) (1 mark)

2. 2. Which body part do we use to make a loud stamping sound? (1 mark)

3. 3. Which body part do we use to make a whistling sound? (1 mark)

4. 4. Max uses his hands to make a clapping sound. Can you name one other sound you can make with your hands? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey singing a happy song. Add musical notes floating in the air around him!



Extension challenge: Try to hum a low note like a growling lion and a high note like a chirping bird. How does your throat feel different?
