

Max's Musical Morning

Learning objective: To identify and draw the parts of the body we use for singing.

Max the monkey is starting a choir! Look at the list of body parts below. Draw Max singing a song and label the parts of his body he uses to make music. Use the word bank to help you.

Draw: Draw Max the monkey standing on a stage with a microphone. Use bright colours. Make sure Max is standing up very straight with his head held high. Add musical notes floating in the air around him.



Label words: lungs · diaphragm · vocal cords · mouth · posture

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw Max standing tall. This is good posture. Label the 'posture' on your drawing.
2. Step 2: Draw an arrow to Max's throat where his 'vocal cords' are. Label them.
3. Step 3: Draw a big circle around Max's chest where his 'lungs' are. Label them.
4. Step 4: Draw an arrow to Max's open 'mouth' so he can sing clearly. Label it.
