Word bank: Djembe drum · Steel pans · Didgeridoo · Koto

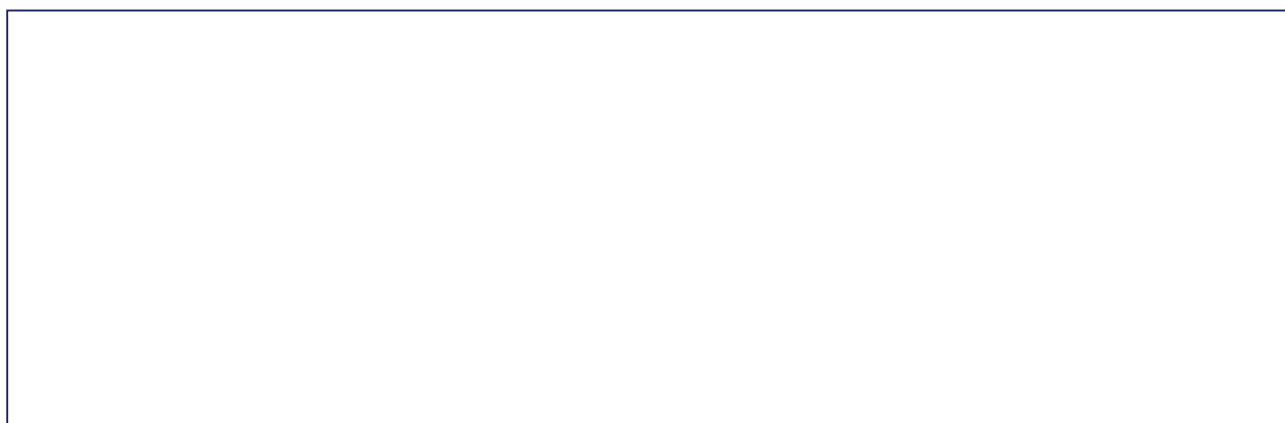
1. 1. I am a wooden pipe from Australia. I make a low, deep sound. What am I? _____
