

Year 4 Outdoor Adventures Assessment

Learning objective: To show understanding of staying safe, working as a team, and identifying skills needed for outdoor activities.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank if you need help. Write your answers on the lines provided.

Max the monkey and Leo the lion are going on a hike. They need to be prepared. They are packing their bags with healthy snacks, a map, and warm layers. They know that working together helps them stay safe and have fun.

Word bank: map · compass · water · sunscreen · teamwork · first aid · shelter · clothing

1. Max and Leo need to find their way. Name one tool they should take to help them find the right path. (1 mark)

2. Why is it important to wear the right clothing, like a waterproof coat, when outdoors? (2 marks)

3. List two things you should pack to help keep you safe and healthy during a long walk. (2 marks)

4. Max thinks teamwork is important. Explain one reason why it is better to explore with a friend than alone. (3 marks)

5. Imagine you are planning an adventure with Leo. Write 3-4 sentences about where you are going, what equipment you will bring, and how you will stay safe. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a rucksack. Inside the rucksack, draw three items you would take on an outdoor adventure.
