Learning objective: To evaluate performance and tactical decision-making in a striking and fielding game.

2. Striking Success: Explain one technique you used to make sure you hit the ball successfully. How did you decide where to aim? (2 marks)

3. Fielding Skills: Which fielding position did you find the most challenging today and why? Think about your movement and reaction time. (2 marks)

4. Communication Check: How did you and your teammates communicate to ensure everyone knew their roles during the match? (2 marks)

5. Next Steps: What is one specific skill you want to practise in the next lesson to improve your overall performance? (1 mark)

Extension challenge: Design a 'perfect' fielding formation for a team of 9 players. Draw the positions on a pitch map and label where each player should stand to cover the most space.
