

My Friendship Fact-File: All About My Friend

Learning objective: To identify the qualities of a good friend and reflect on how we can show kindness and care towards others in our community.

Today, we are celebrating friendship! Think of a special friend you have at school or home. Use this fact-file to tell us all about them. Ask your friend these questions or write down what you know about them. Remember to focus on why they are a kind and helpful person.

Word bank: kind · helpful · funny · sharing · caring · listening · playful · gentle

1. My Friend's Name: Write the name of your friend and tell us one thing that makes you smile when you are with them.

2. Kindness Hero: What is one kind thing your friend has done for you? (For example: sharing a toy or helping you when you were sad).

3. Playing Together: What is your favourite game to play with your friend? Why do you enjoy playing it together?

4. Being a Good Friend: What can YOU do today to be a brilliant friend to them?

5. The Perfect Team: If you and your friend had £5 to spend on a treat to share, what would you buy together and why?

Extension challenge: Draw a picture of yourself and your friend doing something kind together, like sharing a book or helping tidy up the classroom.
