

Kindness Advent: Spreading Joy

Learning objective: To understand the importance of kindness and identify small, actionable ways to show compassion to others during the festive season.

Follow the drawing prompt below to create your own 'Kindness Advent' calendar scene. Add labels from the word bank to explain how your characters are being kind to one another.

Draw: Create a vibrant, warm illustration featuring the BookFlik characters working together to prepare for a kindness celebration. Include a 'Kindness Tree' as the focal point, decorated with hand-drawn paper ornaments. The style should be bright and welcoming, using soft colours. Ensure the characters look happy and engaged in helping one another, such as sharing resources, writing thank-you notes, or offering a helping hand.



Label words: Empathy · Generosity · Compassion · Support · Thoughtfulness · Community

Steps:

1. List two kind actions that Pip the caterpillar or Leo the lion could do for a friend in the community this week.
2. Why is it important to show kindness even when no one is watching? Explain your reasoning.
3. Label your drawing with two words from the word bank that describe the atmosphere of your scene.
4. Step 1: Draw a 'Kindness Tree' in the centre of your page. Decorate the branches with small tags, each

showing a different way to help a neighbour.

5. Step 2: Draw a scene where Nova the owl is sharing a book with a friend. Add speech bubbles showing words of encouragement.
