

Staying Safe with Max and Kit

Learning objective: To understand how to keep ourselves safe in different places and who to ask for help.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you write your answers. Think about what Max the monkey and Kit the fox would do to stay safe.

Word bank: trusted adult · emergency · stranger · safe · help · permission · 999

1. Max the monkey wants to go to the park. Who should he ask before he goes? (1 mark)

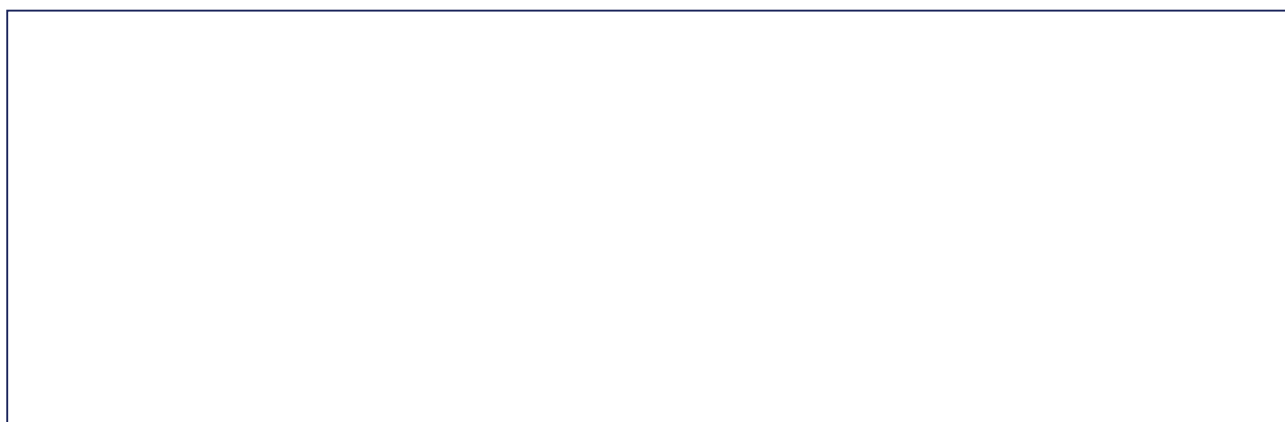
2. If a person you do not know speaks to you, what is the best thing to do? (2 marks)

3. Kit the fox needs help. List two people who are 'trusted adults' you can talk to at school. (2 marks)

4. If there is a big emergency, what number do you call to get help? (1 mark)

5. Why is it important to tell an adult where you are going? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself with a trusted adult. In the speech bubble, write one thing you can say to them if you feel unsafe.
