8. 8. Max the monkey is buying a snack. What is a 'private' detail he should never share with a stranger? A) His favourite colour, B) His home address*, C) His favourite sport, D) The name of his school pet. (1 mark)

9. 9. True or False: You have the right to say 'no' if someone tries to touch you or makes you feel uncomfortable. (True/False) (1 mark)

10. 10. What is the word for a personal limit you set regarding your body or your feelings? (1 word) (1 mark)
