

Nova's Bright Bonfire Night

Learning objective: To learn about the traditions of Bonfire Night and develop fine motor skills through colouring.

Get your brightest crayons or pencils ready! Colour in the scene below, thinking about the warm colours of the fire and the sparkling colours of the fireworks in the night sky. Once you are finished, practise your writing by labelling the parts of the picture.
