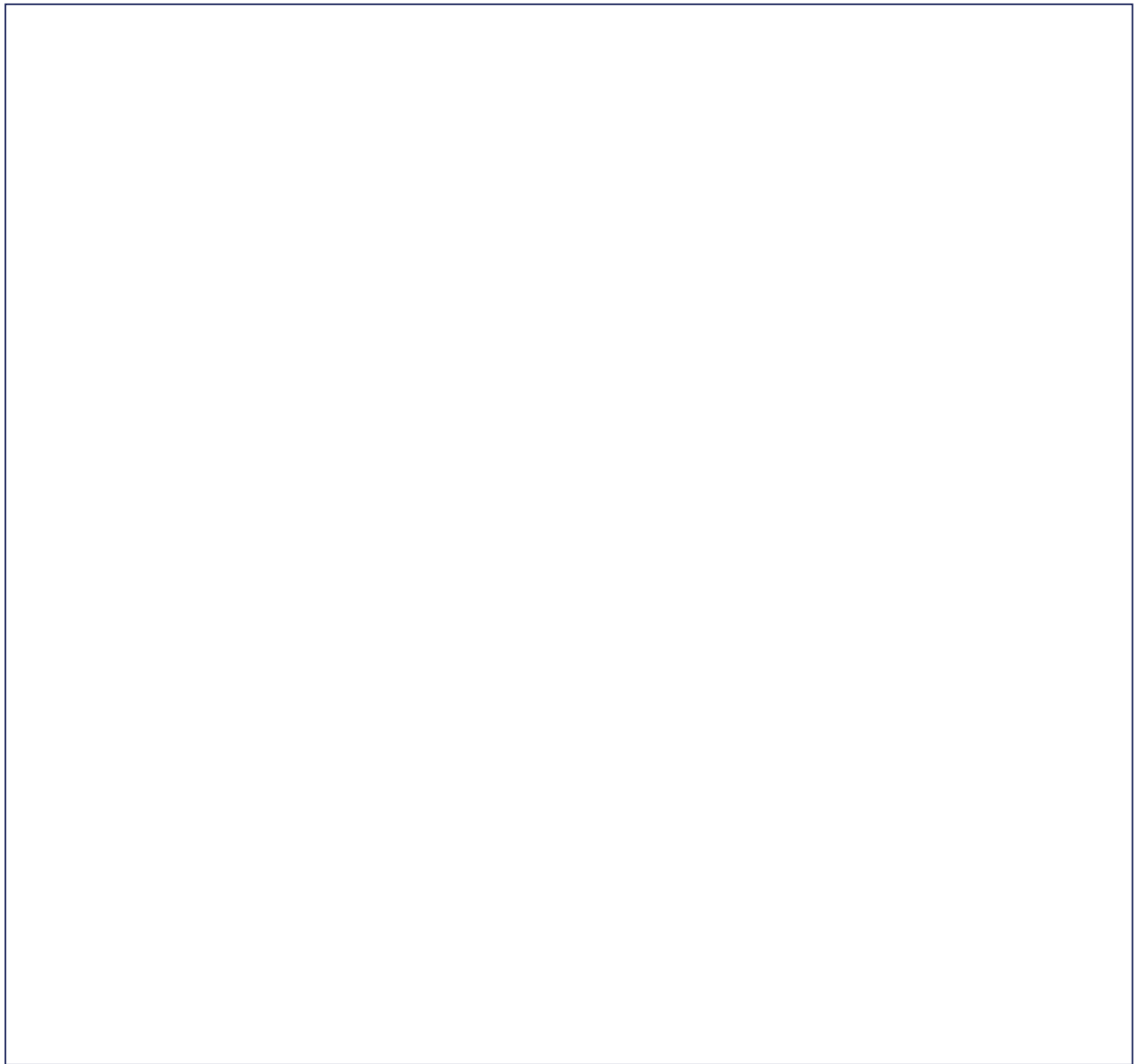


Celebrating Chinese New Year with Zara the Zebra

Learning objective: To explore traditions and cultural celebrations by identifying key symbols associated with Chinese New Year.

Look at the picture of Zara the Zebra celebrating Chinese New Year! Use your brightest red and gold crayons to colour the decorations. After you finish colouring, see if you can label the items in the picture.

Colour this: A large, friendly zebra named Zara standing in the centre wearing a traditional-style festive vest. She is holding a small, rectangular red envelope decorated with a simple gold pattern. Above Zara, there are two large, round paper lanterns hanging from a string. To the side, there is a small fan with a floral design. The outlines should be thick and bold, suitable for young children to colour within the lines.
