

My Christianity Discovery Page with Ellie the Elephant

Learning objective: To identify and describe key features of Christianity, including special places, symbols, and stories, as part of the EYFS Understanding the World curriculum.

Help Ellie the Elephant learn about Christianity! Use this template to explore what you have discovered about the Christian faith. You can write words or draw pictures in the boxes to share what you have learned. Talk to your teacher or grown-up about each section as you fill it in.

1. Special Places: Where do Christians go to pray and gather together? Describe or draw what you might see there.

2. The Holy Book: What is the name of the special book that Christians read, and what kind of stories are inside?

3. Special Symbols: Draw or describe a symbol used in Christianity, such as the cross, and explain what it reminds people of.

4. Helping Others: Christians believe in showing kindness. What is one way you can be kind to a friend today?

5. My Favourite Fact: What is the most interesting thing you have learned about Christianity so far?

Extension challenge: Ask an adult to help you find a picture of a stained-glass window. Use colours to design your own window that shows a story of kindness.
