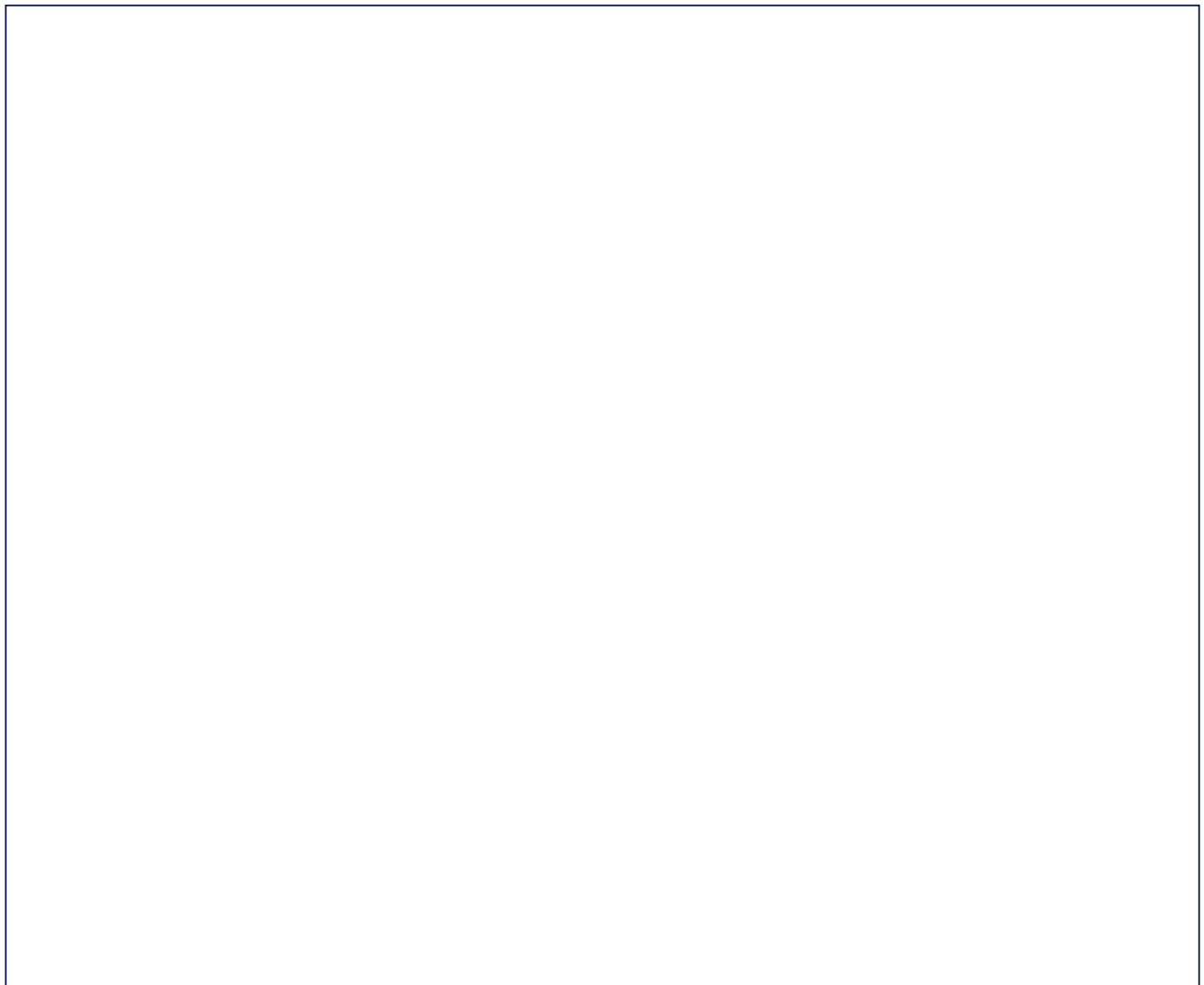


Leo the Lion's Christmas Celebration

Learning objective: To explore traditions and symbols of Christmas while developing fine motor skills and creative expression.

Follow the steps below to create your very own Christmas scene with Leo the Lion. Use your favourite colours to make the picture bright and festive!

Draw: Draw a festive scene featuring Leo the Lion standing in a cosy room. Include a Christmas tree with hanging baubles and tinsel, and at least two wrapped presents on the floor. Use bright, cheerful colours like gold, red, and green. The style should be simple and clear, suitable for early years colouring and drawing.



Label words: star · tinsel · gift · bauble · tree · lion

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large Christmas tree next to Leo. What shape is the top of the tree?
2. Step 2: Draw a shiny star at the very top of your tree. Why do we put stars on trees?
3. Step 3: Draw two colourful gifts on the floor for Leo to give to his friends. How many gifts did you draw in total?
4. Step 4: Draw a circle around the word 'bauble' in the word bank. What colour will you make your baubles?
5. Step 5: Label the lion in your picture using the word 'lion' from the word bank.
