

The Wonder of Our World

Learning objective: To explore the idea of creation by identifying that many people believe the world was made with care and purpose.

Read the questions with an adult and share your thoughts about the beautiful world around us. Use the word bank to help you answer.

Many people around the world believe that our Earth is a very special place. They tell stories about how everything we see—the tall trees, the deep blue oceans, and the bright shining stars—was made with love and purpose. These stories help us look after the world and all the living things that share it with us.

1. Nova the owl loves looking at the stars. If you were making a brand new world, what is one thing you would make first? (2 marks)

2. Why do you think it is important to take good care of the flowers and trees in our world? (2 marks)

3. Look at the word bank. Which word describes how the world looks to you? (1 mark)

4. Bea the bee works hard in the garden. Can you name two things in nature that you think are wonderful? (2 marks)

5. If you could tell a story about how the bright sun was made, what would you say? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of your favourite thing in the world. It could be a giant mountain, a tiny ladybird, or a big, fluffy cloud!



Extension challenge: Go on a 'Wonder Walk' outside with an adult. Find three things that you think are truly amazing and explain why you think they are special.
