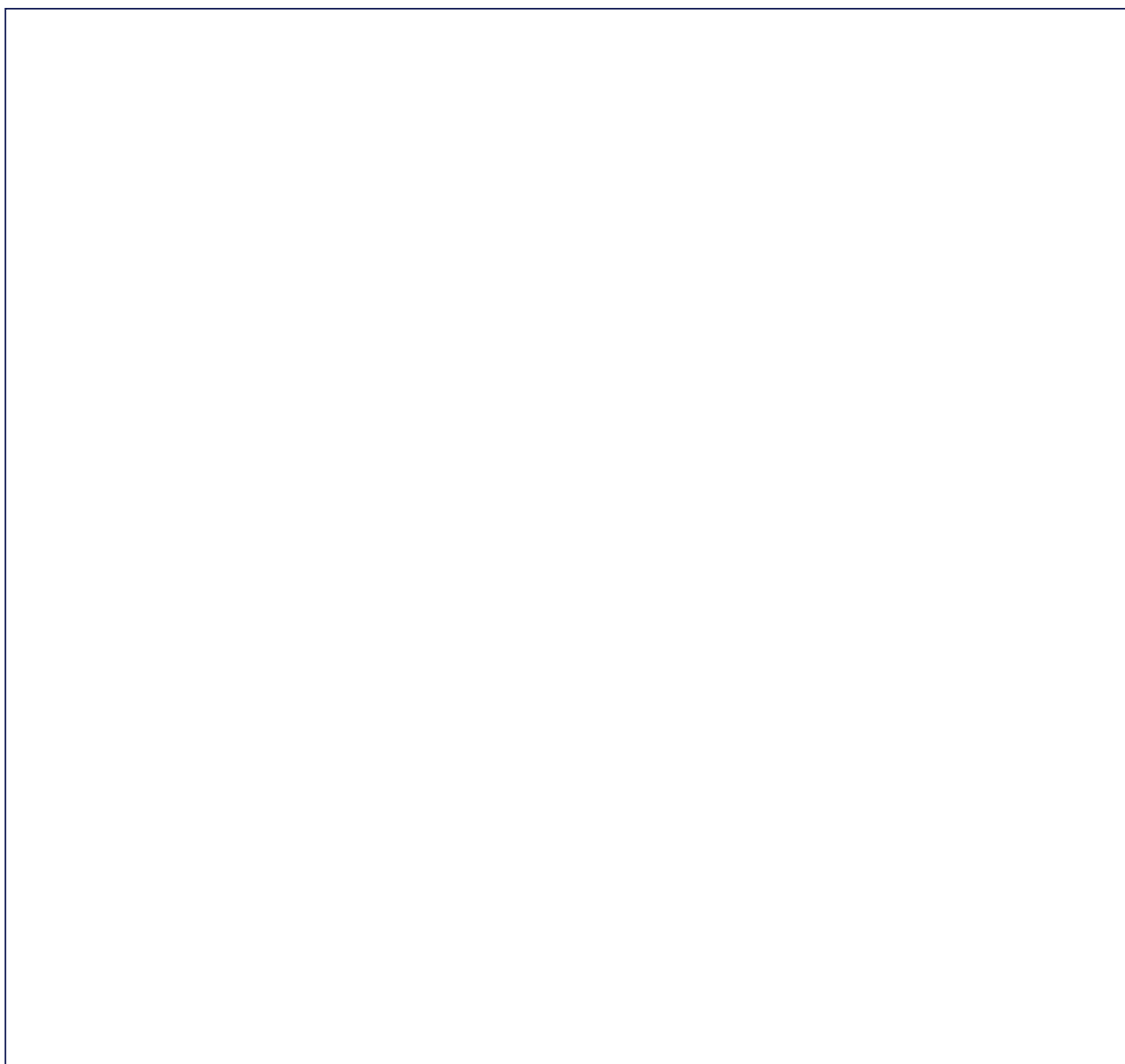


Zara's Diwali Celebration

Learning objective: To learn about the Hindu festival of Diwali by exploring symbols of light and patterns.

Welcome to our Diwali colouring page! Zara the zebra loves the bright colours of Diwali. Look at the patterns on the rangoli design and choose your favourite colours to make them shine. Read the fun facts with an adult to learn why Diwali is known as the Festival of Lights.

Colour this: A clean, simple line-art illustration for children to colour. In the centre is a beautiful, symmetrical rangoli pattern made of circles, triangles, and flower-petal shapes. Surrounding the pattern are four small 'diyas' (clay oil lamps) with bright, flickering flames drawn as simple teardrop shapes. Steps:

1. Label the diya (the small lamp) in your picture.
