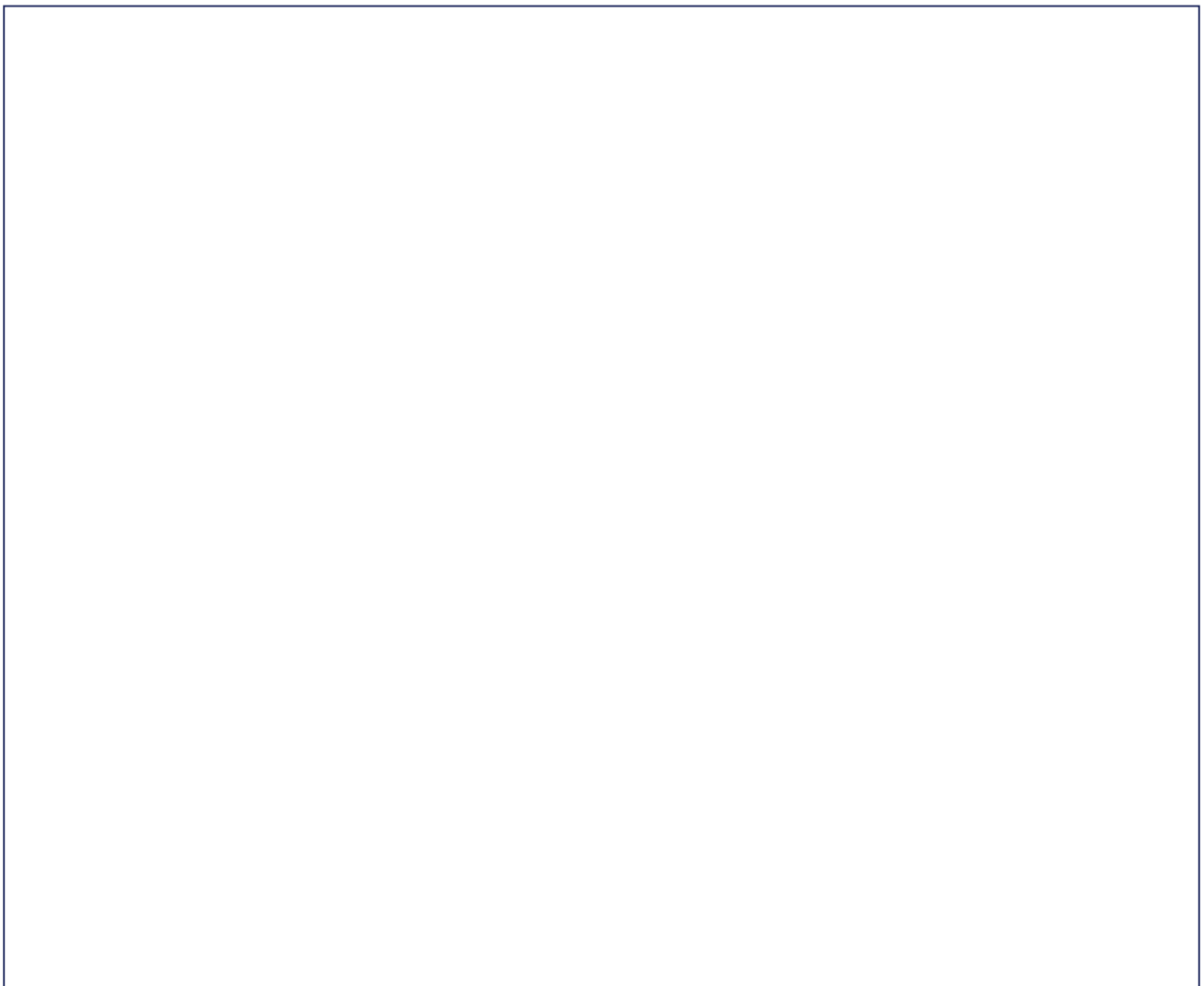


Celebrating Eid with Ellie

Learning objective: To understand and represent the celebration of Eid through drawing and labelling, showing awareness of different cultural traditions.

Today, Ellie the Elephant is getting ready for Eid! Use your crayons or pencils to draw a beautiful celebration scene. Follow the steps below to complete your picture, and use the word bank to add labels to your drawing.

Draw: Draw a joyful scene featuring a table set for an Eid celebration. Include a large, glowing crescent moon in the top corner of the sky. On the table, draw a shiny metal lantern, a stack of wrapped gifts with bows, and a plate of sweet treats like biscuits or dates. Ensure the style is bright, cheerful, and welcoming, with plenty of room to add labels near each object.



Label words: Moon · Lantern · Gift · Card · Treats

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a bright, crescent moon in the night sky. Why do people look for the moon at the start of Eid?
2. Step 2: Draw a beautiful lantern to light up the celebration. How does a lantern make a room feel special?
3. Step 3: Draw a colourful gift wrapped with a ribbon. Who would you like to give a gift to?

4. Step 4: Draw a plate of delicious treats to share with friends and family. What is your favourite thing to eat at a party?
5. Step 5: Label your drawing using the words from the word bank.
