

Celebrating Eid with Zara and Max

Learning objective: To understand that Eid is a special time of celebration for Muslims, involving family, sharing, and kindness.

Look at the pictures and think about how people celebrate Eid. Use the word bank to help you answer the questions about this special time.

Word bank: Family · New clothes · Sharing · Eid Mubarak · Presents · Special food

1. Zara the zebra is wearing her best clothes for Eid. Why do you think people like to wear new or smart clothes for a celebration? (2 marks)

2. Max the monkey has 3 coins worth £1 each to give as a gift. How much money does he have altogether? Write the total in pounds. (1 mark)

3. Eid is a time for 'sharing'. Can you name one way you can share with your friends or family? (2 marks)

4. People often say 'Eid Mubarak' to each other. What does this greeting tell us about how they feel? (2 marks)

5. If you were planning an Eid party, what special food would you choose to share with your friends? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of a beautiful crescent moon in the sky above a house, to show how the celebration of Eid begins.



Extension challenge: Talk to an adult about a time you celebrated a special day with your family. What made it feel happy and kind?
